COVID-19 Pandemic – Proof of Vaccination
Public Notice – September 22, 2021**

Effective September 22, 2021 the Province of Ontario released new regulations and guidance for businesses and organizations for the implementation for the proof of vaccination requirements.

Proof of vaccination will not be required if entering the Township Office for paying taxes, drop-off or pick-off of documents, etc. We encourage you to call ahead to book an appointment if needed and choose virtual meetings whenever possible.

Any person, 12 years of age or older, entering a facility for an indoor function or meeting that is not delivering or supporting a government service will be required, at point of entry, to provide proof of vaccination (two doses plus 14 days) along with photo ID, unless there is proof of a medical exemption.

Current capacity restrictions will remain in place, as per the Province and Public Health Guidelines.

Please maintain physical distancing of at least two (2) metres from any other person who is using the amenity. If physical distancing cannot be obtained of at least two (2) metres then a mask **MUST** be worn. All COVID-19 protocols must be followed.
